



We Accept:

Appliances: Refrigerators, electric and gas ranges, range hoods, washing machines, dryers, and small kitchen appliances must be less than 10 years old, clean, missing no parts or accessories, and in full working condition.

Furniture: Overall excellent condition. Upholstered items must be clean, free of stains, tears, or damage. Cushions must not be sunken in from wear.

Cabinets: Must have all doors, drawers, pulls, and hardware included and attached.

Household Goods: cookware, art, and other home décor must have no visible signs of damage and should be cleaned before donating.

Bricks, Blocks, & Pavers: These are drop-off only donations and minimum amount to donate is 25 pieces.

Flooring (Tile, Laminate, And Hardwood): donation must be of new and unused flooring of at least 20sq. ft and in boxes; no loose tile or flooring.

Lighting: floor and table lamps w/ intact shades, ceiling fans, light fixtures should all be in working condition and all hardware must be included. No fluorescent lights or fixtures and no recessed lighting.

Lumber: 4'or longer, sheet, free of rot/warping/nails/screws

Plumbing: toilets, vanities, shower enclosures, sinks, and claw foot tubs. Must be clean, porcelain should be unblemished and show no cracking or chipping, and toilets must contain functional inner plumbing.

Roofing: unopened, non-damaged bundles, non-expired adhesives, and unused gutters.

Tools: hand or power tools, in good working condition with all parts, cords, and batteries intact + no rusting.

Windows/Doors: All windows must be wood or vinyl, new construction or retrofit windows and NO metal frames or single pane. All interior, exterior, screen, and security doors must be in new or like-new condition. Please remove doorknobs and bag them to donate separately. No broken glass or damaged wood.
